This workshop focuses on the core principles of painting from life and interpreting what you see accurately. Instruction is customized for the individual's specific needs. Experience demonstrations and discussions to gain the insight needed to begin a painting with a live subject. Review the fundamentals of a painting: drawing, color, value and edge. Learn how they work together to convey your vision to the viewer. Learn to simplify what you see and break down a painting into manageable pieces. Receive valuable feedback from the instructor and your classmates in daily critiques while learning the questions to ask yourself in order to critique your own work.
